*Shuttle buses to Whistler will keep passengers connected
with innovative, Vancouver-bred technology*

The integrated GPS capability will enable SnowBus management and passengers to track the location of buses at any time. Live video will also be streamed from the buses during the games.

Gateways can be equipped to roam across several networks to achieve unmatched communications reliability. A comprehensive suite of management software also enables agencies to manage and monitor mobile networks.
