SNOWBUS is applying to the Passenger Transportation Board to amend its licence, application changes are noted below.

RE: Public Notice of Application to Reduce Minimum Route Frequency

1. Change Route #1 (Richmond – Whistler) as follows:

- Reduce minimum frequency on the route from 2 round trips per day to 4 round trips per week.
- Change Richmond and West Van from scheduled service to reservation-only service

2. Change Route #2 (Burnaby - Whistler) as follows:

- Reduce minimum frequency on the route from 3 round trips per week to 1 round trip per week.
